1.) ALL ABOARD!

Last Names Ending in A-H: Arrive at 7:00am Last Names Ending in I-P: Arrive at 7:30am Last Names Ending in Q-Z: Arrive at 8:00am



No one is permitted outside of their vehicle at any time while awaiting the start of or during the parade.

3.) SIGNAGE & DECOR

Name: In order to have your graduate's name announced, your graduate's name must be clearly visible on the passenger side of the vehicle or on the passenger side dashboard.

Vehicles:

Your name will be announced over the loud speaker along the parade route. You <u>MUST</u> affix a large poster board or similar to the outside of your vehicle or on the dashboard. You can also choose to decorate the vehicle in a graduation theme.

Attire:


We expect all graduates to proudly wear their caps and gowns with caps decorated.
