



CAMBRIDGE DIPLOMA REQUIREMENTS

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- Students will take courses in all four categories of the Cambridge International Program
- Students must pass seven Cambridge exams including the Global Perspectives exam
- Students must complete all Cambridge coursework within 25-months of sitting for the first Cambridge International exam*
- Additional Cambridge International courses will be added to the school schedule

AICE DIPLOMA & BRIGHT FUTURES

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AICE Diploma and Bright Futures:

**Students who earn an <u>AICE diploma</u> based on AICE exams taken prior to and during the high school graduation exam administration series ending mid-June, complete 100 hours of community service, and submit their *Florida Financial Aid Applications* by their high school graduation date, will earn the Florida Academic Scholars award.

Completion of the AICE curriculum would require students to complete seven AICE courses and take the examinations for each with at least one course and examination being from each of the three subject areas: Mathematics & Sciences, Languages, and Arts & Humanities.

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Diploma Designations

Scholar Designation

In addition to meeting the 24-credit standard high school diploma requirements, a student must

- Earn 1 credit in Algebra 2;
- Earn 1 credit in statistics or an equally rigorous mathematics course;
- Pass the Biology 1 EOC;
- Earn 1 credit in chemistry or physics;
- Earn 1 credit in a course equally rigorous to chemistry or physics;
- Pass the U.S. History EOC;
- Earn 2 credits in the same world language; and
- Earn at least 1 credit in AP, IB, AICE or a dual enrollment course.


A student is exempt from the Biology 1 or U.S. History assessment if the student is enrolled in an AP, IB, or AICE Biology 1 or U.S. History course and the student

- Takes the respective AP, IB or AICE assessment; and
- Earns the minimum score to earn college credit.



Merit Designation

- Meet the standard high school diploma requirements
- Attain one or more industry certifications from the list established (per s.1003.492, F.S.)




