A Day in Kindergarten

- 20 minutes of recess each day



Helping your child prepare tor Kindergarten

- Learn how to hold a pencil
- Learn how to cut with scissors
- Count objects / Identify numbers 1-20
- Write my first and last name
- Identify BOTH uppercase and lowercase letters
- Identify letter sounds
- Identify basic shapes
- Identify color words
- Practice zipping, buttoning, tying shoes, opening and closing containers.

- School starts promptly at 8:00 AM




Kindergarten Dismissal

- ❖ Bus students are escorted by adults
- * Aftercare students are picked up at their classrooms
- ❖ Kindergarten car riders are taken to the covered car pick-up area "Glass Block" and supervised by K-1 teachers.
- ❖ Older siblings meet Kindergarten siblings in the media center and dismiss together at the older dismissal area.
- ❖ Please keep Kindergarten dismissal consistent for your child
- ❖ Any changes to dismissal should be communicated in writing to your child's teacher <u>at least 24 hours in advance</u>.


