Walter C. Young Middle School Unified Dress Code Policy





The following is the unified dress code for the 2021-2022 school year:

Tops: White, blue, or black solid color polo shirts with a collar and long enough to cover the midriff when arms are raised. The shirt size must be appropriate to the size of the child. The shirt tail should not extend below the torso. Jackets, hoodies and sweaters can be worn only if uniform polo is underneath. No shirt should be worn over the polo shirt.

Bottoms: Khakis, jeans, or khaki cargo pants. Denim jeans (only blue or black in color) are permitted, but must not be tight fitting. Tears or rips are not permitted. Shorts, skirts and skorts are to be at least knee length and must be hemmed. All trousers or pants must be secured at waist level.

Footwear: Closed toe and close heeled shoes (no sandals or flip flops).

Inappropriate Dress: No lycra, spandex, nylon, velour, stretch, or seethrough materials. No sweat pants or shirts, draw-string pants, sleepwear, flannel bottoms, leggings, low cut/hipster styled pants, athletic attire, tank tops, clothes with holes or form-fitting. No jumpsuits, overalls or jumpers. Polo shirts are not to be removed throughout the day. Multi-layers of t-shirts should not be worn under the polo shirt. Excessively oversized shirts are not allowed. In addition, all students are required to adhere to the dress code requirements as stated in the Broward County School Code of Conduct always.
