this level separately in your school).for county


<u>MIDDLE SCHOOLS</u>: Each grade level should be judged separately, and <u>one</u> <u>first place poster from each grade level</u> (total of three posters) may be submitted.


<u>HIGH SCHOOLS</u>: Each high school should determine its categories for judging and <u>may submit a total of four posters, one for each grade level.</u>

<u>CENTERS</u>: May submit <u>four posters</u>, one for each grade level.

REGULATIONS:

- 1. All poster arrangements and artwork must be done by the contestant. <u>No</u> <u>cutouts, pasted on, or attached materials of any type may be used.</u> Any art media, including felt tip markers, crayons, watercolor, or acrylics may be used.
- 2. All work must be original.
- 3. <u>All posters should be 16" x 22", including mat. Posters submitted</u> <u>for county judging must be matted.</u> Posters competing only in local school competition do not have to be matted.
- 4. Posters must be identified with the labels provided.** <u>Place the label</u> on the lower right-hand corner of the poster.
- 5. All posters submitted for county judging <u>must be created and mounted</u>, so that the art work is displayed <u>vertically. (See example below)</u>

Broward County Public Schools Food and Nutrition Services Poster Contest Rules 2019 - 20

JUDGING: Register your school to participate in the poster contest by submitting the Registration Form (Attachment A) by *Wednesday, September 4, 2019*.

Each school should conduct judging of its posters by *Friday*, *September 13, 2019*.

A list of winners must be returned to the Food and Nutrition Services office by *Friday, September 20, 2019,* in order for ribbons and certificates to be received by National School Lunch Week.

Winning posters for each grade must be submitted to Food and Nutrition Services department by *Monday*, *September 23, 2019, at 4:00 p.m.*

It is suggested that each school select a panel of three or four judges, including the Food and Nutrition Services manager or a representative from the Food and Nutrition Services department. A first-, second-, and third-place winner in each category should be chosen. Posters should be judged on the following criteria:

- 1. Relationship to theme: "School Lunch: What's On Your Playlist?".
- 2. Promotion of good nutrition and school lunch.
- 3. Originality, neatness, spelling, and compliance with contest regulations.
- **AWARDS:** The Food and Nutrition Services department will provide first-, second-, and third-place ribbons and certificates for each category to schools registering.

The <u>first-place winning</u> posters must also be received by the Food and Nutrition Services department by <u>Monday, September 23, 2019, at 4:00 p.m.</u>, to be eligible for county judging. <u>All posters must be sent or brought to the</u> <u>Food and Nutrition Services office, TSSC Building, 7720 West Oakland</u> <u>Park Blvd, Suite 204, Sunrise, Florida, in an artist's portfolio to prevent</u> <u>damage.</u>

<u>SUGGESTIONS:</u> School poster winners may also act as host or hostess to special guests who may visit the cafeteria during National School Lunch Week, <u>October 14 – 18, 2019</u>, and should be seated at a special table during this week.

<u>Display posters</u> in the cafeteria during NATIONAL SCHOOL LUNCH WEEK or for the entire month of October.

All first-place winners in each approved category must be submitted to the Food and Nutrition Services office for county judging by <u>Monday, September 23, 2019</u>.
