<u>Tops</u>	Solid colored (no stripes, plaid, patterned, etc.) short sleeved collared polo type shirt or oxford style dress shirt. Colors: Blue (any shade), Green (any shade), Black, White, Grey, Pink
<u>Undershirts</u>	May not be visible through the uniform top – no colors or graphic designs that show.
<u>Outerwear</u>	Jackets, Sweaters, Cardigans – must be an approved uniform top color (see above) and student will be asked to show appropriate uniform top underneath the outerwear. Cannot have offensive language and/or graphic designs.
<u>Bottoms</u>	Docker or cargo style pants or capris, walking shorts or skirts (just above or at knee length or longer). All bottoms, including oversized or low-hanging, must be worn and secured at waist level. **Colors:* Khaki, Navy Blue, Black, Grey**
<u>Shoes</u>	Athletic type shoes are recommended. Bedroom slippers, flip-flops, and slides are not allowed. Closed toe shoes are required for safety reasons in certain programs or activities such as physical education, career/technical education, and science.
<u>School Logo</u>	Logo is not required but, if desired, tops with the school logo may be purchased from approved local uniform vendors.
