Welcome to the 2018-19 School Year! As we begin this new school year we are putting out this newsletter to keep you up to date with pertinent information to ensure you are aware of important items as it relates to schoolwide daily policies and procedures. ID BADGES ARE A MUST!

To ensure appropriate identification of students, the School District is requiring that all students and staff wear **ID Badges** at all times. Tequesta Trace will give each student their first temporary badge the first day of school, and then a photo badge after school pictures are taken. Additionally, each student will be given one lanyard to use to display the ID badge at all times. The lanyards will be color coded to match the student's grade level. Students will need to purchase a new ID if they lose or misplace the one provided. Students without their ID badge will be monitored and could face progressive discipline per the District Discipline Matrix. As this is a safety matter, Parents, I need your help in sending your student(s) with their ID badge every day.

Single Point of Entry /Arrival and Dismissal Procedures

As our single point of entry gets closer to completion, please know that how parents and students are admitted to the building will now be as follows:

*All students will enter the building through the cafeteria doors before school begins.

*Students should not be on campus before 8:40 AM. Any student or student groups that will be meeting or practicing with a teacher before or after 8:40 AM will meet that teacher at the Cafeteria Doors at a pre-determined time to be escorted by that teacher.

*Parents and visitors will be allowed to enter campus beginning at 8:00AM when the doors are unlocked. Our new single point of entry when opened will be known as the Cougars' Den. It will be a location for all late signins, early sign-outs and where all business with the office or guidance will begin. Please know that you will always need to have your government issued photo ID with you to be allowed on campus, and you will be processed through the Security Tracking and Response (STAR) System, and escorted to your destination.

SCHOOLWIDE DRILLS

All Broward County Public schools are required to perform monthly Fire and Code Red Drills to ensure all safety protocols and practices are adhered to by students, staff and visitors to the campus. All parents/guardians will be notified of schoolwide drills one day prior to the drill via a Parentlink.

Please ensure your child/children understand the importance of all drills and adhering to directions provided by the supervising adult. At the conclusion, of all drills we will resume our regular daily practices.

TTMS Unified Dress Code

Parents, I also need your help in making sure your student(s) come to school in the proper unified dress code. Students must wear either a solid colored polo shirt or Tequesta Trace Spirit Shirt each day, even if it is under their jacket or sweat shirt. Pants or shorts must be either Navy, Black or Khaki in color; No blue jeans or sweat pants are allowed to be worn (except on cold weather days which will be pre-announced). All other dress code provisions of the Code of Student Conduct will be followed.

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<u>Athletics</u>

All TTMS students who are interested in participating on one of our teams (Soccer, Basketball, Volleyball, Flag Football, Cross Country, Golf) <u>must submit paperwork in</u> <u>advance</u> by visiting <u>www.registermyathlete.com</u>

You will need to register your child and print out and fill in two different forms and submit prior to tryouts. No student can attend any TTMS practice without completing this process.

There will be meetings for tryouts for boys' and girls' soccer, cross country, and golf during the second week of school. Listen for announcements in the morning, during lunch, and watch for posters around the school.
