ID BADGES ARE A MUST!

To ensure appropriate identification of students, the School District is requiring that all students and staff wear ID Badges at all times. Tequesta Trace will give each student their first ID badge the first day of school, and then a photo ID badge after school pictures are taken. After the 4th request of an ID badge, students will be charged a \$5.00 obligation. All obligations must be paid online. Additionally, each student will be given one lanyard to use to display the ID badge at all times. The lanyards will be color coded to match the student's grade level. Students without their ID badge will be monitored and could face progressive discipline per the District Discipline Matrix. As this is a safety matter, Parents, I need your help in sending your student(s) with their ID badge every day.

Single Point of Entry / Arrival and Dismissal Procedures

All students will enter the building through the cafeteria doors before school begins.

*Students should not be on campus before 8:40 AM. Any student or student groups that will be meeting or practicing with a teacher before or after 8:40 AM will meet that teacher outside of the Cougar's Den at a pre-determined time to be escorted by that teacher.

*Parents and visitors will be allowed to enter campus beginning at 8:10AM when the doors are unlocked. Our single point of entry is known as the Cougars' Den. It is the location for all late sign-ins, early sign-outs and where all business with the office or guidance will begin. Please know that you will always need to have your government issued photo ID with you to be allowed on campus, and you will be processed through the Security Tracking and Response (STAR) System, and escorted to your destination.

Students are dismissed at 3:40PM and will exit through the bus circle area. Car riders will walk through the bus circle and across the walkway to the front of the school. They will remain at the car rider line until picked up. Bike riders please use bus circle to exit campus. Additionally, you are to wear your helmet at all times and walk your bike off school grounds.

ISCHOOLWIDE DRILLS

All Broward County Public schools are required to perform monthly Fire and Code Red Drills to ensure all safety protocols and practices are adhered to by students, staff and visitors to the campus. All parents/guardians will be notified of schoolwide Code Red drills prior to via a Parentlink.

Please ensure your child/children understand the importance of all drills and adhering to directions provided by the supervising adult. At the conclusion, of all drills we will resume our regular daily practices.

TTMS Unified Dress Code

Parents, I also need your help in making sure your student(s) come to school in the proper unified dress code. Students must wear either a solid colored polo shirt or Tequesta Trace Spirit Shirt each day, even if it is under their jacket or sweat shirt. Pants or shorts must be either Navy, Black or Khaki in color; No blue jeans, sweat pants, leggings or athletic shorts are permitted (except on cold weather days which will be pre-announced). All other dress code provisions of the Code of Student Conduct will be followed.
