- School Improvement Plan (SIP)
  - All required documents have been uploaded into the system.
  - Currently in the process of completing Best Practices of Inclusive Education (BPIE), which is a missing component.

- Equity
  - Ms. Barnes uploaded the equity plan to KickUP.
  - The current Student Learning and Achievement goal is to achieve 53% of students making learning gains in ELA, Math, and Science as measured by the FAST by June 2023.
  - o Mr. Johnson presented the school's 2022 2023 FAST goals.
    - Mr. Johnson made note that learning gains will not count this year but will count next year.
    - Progress Monitoring 3 will take place in May 2023.
  - When it comes to our Safe and Supportive Environment goal, 80% of the staff will have completed their Youth Mental Health First Aid professional development by June 2023.
  - The Student Engagement goal is by the end of December 2022, our students will participate in Choose Peace, Stop Violence, and Anti-Bullying campaigns.
- Social and Emotional Learning (SEL)
  - Ms. Roberts talked about the staff receiving an SEL training for new and veteran teachers on November 8<sup>th</sup>.
  - The Iron Chef Cooking Competition for the staff will also occur on November 8<sup>th</sup> in an effort to build school culture.

### **Principal's Report**

- School Info
  - The boys' and girls' basketball teams are currently undefeated
  - The accountability funds balance is currently at \$25,161.18.
    - Quorum is needed to spend these funds.
      - Funds are replenished on a yearly basis
  - SESIR data (discipline data) of the school was presented by Mr. Johnson
    - Also available on the Diversity & Climate site on <u>www.browardschools.com</u>
      - Infractions include habitual defiance and dress code violations
        - o FYI... Hoodies are not allowed.
    - The district has been on campus twice for random searches.
    - The School Resource Officer (SRO) monitors the campus
  - As a Verizon (VILS) school, we will be obtaining a 5G lab in room 302. Every student will access to this lab. Room 301 will be the STEM lab.
  - Currently, student obligations range from as little as \$4 to as high as \$511. Students with these obligations will not be allowed to attend any events or field trips until it is paid in full.
    - We are willing to aid parents in this process. A payment plan could be devised, if necessary.
  - After school Extended Learning Opportunities (ELOs) are currently in session Monday through Thursday after school.
    - ELOs are for core subjects only from 3:20 4:20 p.m.
      - Working on getting an instructor for Algebra as students are currently getting tutored by Piper High math group
  - Reports will be available in Virtual Counselor on November 10<sup>th</sup>.
