- AB Honor Roll

 - o Straight A students, all 80 of them, will celebrate tomorrow with a pizza party
- FSA/EOC Testing
 - o Testing began and will continue until May 16, 2019
- Math Coach
 - o Due to the drop in Math scores with sixth grade last year, we will be getting a Math coach
- Artists Rendering 2019/2020 School Year
 - Murals will be painted around the school
 - o Mr. Johnson showed examples of various murals

- Westpine Middle School Soar and Explore Summer Program
 - o First come, first serve for the first 100 applicants and the program will last 3 weeks
 - Geared towards incoming 5th graders
- Course Recovery and ESE Assistance
 - SAC unanimously voted to use accountability funds to pay for salaries of teachers, paraprofessionals, clerical and/or a member of the guidance department to run course recovery and provide ESE assistance
- Social Emotional Learning (S.E.L.)
 - This year, we began with equity liaisons as the ambassadors in this project with Ms. Barnes and Ms. Thomas-Bass
 - Next year, the program will consist of 5 components, which will result in a shift in school culture, but this process will take a few years
 - This will force us to look at the climate of the school and how we are shaping and nurturing the adults and students
- Home Depot Beautification Project
 - Ms. Roberts partnered with Home Depot and they will begin a beautification project which involves revamping the memorial butterfly garden, the front of the media center and office, as well as the sitting area in front of the art room
