Testing Update- Mrs. Keery

- New Florida Assessment of Student Thinking (FAST) test for ELA and Math. Science, EOC courses, and Civics still follow the NGSSS or prior test format but will now have same quick reporting. FAST occurs in 3 PM windows, PM 1 and PM 2 are for "in house" monitoring, PM 3 is for school accountability. Parents and teachers will have access to the score reports within days of completing the FAST PM tests. The PM 1 testing will occur in September, PM 2 in early December, and PM 3 in May.
