
#### **ATTENTION ALL RISING 7th GRADERS:**

Prior to entering the 7th grade, all students must provide a Florida Certificate of Immunization (DH 680) stating that their immunizations are complete for 7th grade entry. Please note that in addition to compliance with all other required immunizations, children entering the 7th grade in Florida schools must have received one dose of the tetanus-diphtheria-pertussis (Tdap) vaccine.

Your child may need additional immunizations and/or you may just need to turn in the updated DH 680 form. You may request the form from your child's physician's office or visit a public health center.

The BCPS Summer Experience is a free six-week experience that starts Monday, June 21, and runs through Thursday, July 29, 2021. Certified teachers will provide face-to-face instruction and CDC safety guidelines will be followed including mandatory mask-wearing, physical distancing, and other health and safety protocols.

Transportation and meals will be provided, and before and after school childcare services are available for participating students. Classes will be held on our very own campus, Monday through Thursday, for four hours a day, from 9:30-1:30. There are two different options for the Summer Experience. Students will be able to attend for credit recovery or acceleration.

#### **Credit Recovery**

Students needing the opportunity to retake courses required for graduation can take advantage of these summer course offerings. Eligible middle grades students will have the opportunity to enroll in one of several different courses. Eligible students can receive up to 1.0 credits successfully completing the course requirements and get back on track for a timely graduation. The in-person program will take place from Monday to Thursday and will run from June 21 to July 29.

#### **Acceleration Program**

This acceleration program will give students a head start in the study of grade-level accelerated courses and give participants an opportunity to continue in an accelerated pathway in years to come. Students can receive acceleration in math or language arts and will be placed in courses designed to give them skills needed to be successful in these subject areas for the next grade level.

WMS MATH CLUB

Our Math Club has been busy competing in competitions and we are so proud!

We had 34 students competing at the school level in the national AMC (American Mathematic Competition).

13 WMS students competed for the Broward Chapter of Mathcounts and 3 qualified for the state competition: Jayden Lang, Kevin Liu and Darsh Patel. Out of the 3 students going to state competition, 2 students won the state and qualified to the national competition: **Kevin Liu and Jayden Lang**. There were a total of 55,000 students that participated at the county level. 22,000 students at the state level and 240 students at the national level. Kevin and Jayden were among these students.

23 students participated in the Math Olympiad. **Darsh Patel** came in 1st Place. We participated in the FAU
Math Day 2020 competition and got 3rd Place: **Kevin Liu, Jyden Lang, Darsh Patel and Derek Kehler.** 

BCCTM is a Broward County competition for every level. Our Geometry Team won 3rd Place. The team was formed of: Ishika Gadani, Preeti Kumar, Eashaan Murthy Juliana Webster, Ivan Yuk and Raz Kashuv. Sanvi Shankar won 1st Place at EMF 6th grade level. Kevin Liu won 1st place at EMF 8th grade level. Rajam Arunprakash won 2nd place at EMF 8th grade level.



NJHS members took the NPFH pledge and committed to the NOEA initiative. It was posted by ELA teachers on their Canvas.




#### We Can't Mask Our Gratitude!


