


Principal's Notes

School Safety Updates

During the 2017-2018 school year, our community faced a tremendous tragedy. Westglades is committed to keeping our students safe and has added many safety enhancements. The safety enhancements that were completed during the 2017-2018 school year include:

- -Locking mechanisms added to strategic entrances.
- -Mirrored laminate added to strategic windows.
- -Security cameras added.
- -First aid stop the bleed kits in each classroom and training for faculty and community.
- -Enhanced door security.
- -ID badges required by students and staff.
- -Parking decals for staff.
- -Classroom safe zones identified and marked in each classroom.
- -New security position added.

Westglades is continuing to enhance security, and during the 2018-2019 school year our school's safety enhancements include:

- -Additional security position hired and an additional law enforcement position (Total of 3 security positions and 2 law enforcement officers).
- -Procedural change for East side gates.
- -Additional first aid/stop the bleed consultation and training for staff and community.
- -ID badges will be required to be worn by staff and students. Students will receive their ID badges within the first week of school.
- -Hero software to track and reward positive behaviors.
- -Adding a full-time family counselor to meet with families as a group or individually to discuss emotional issues and provide treatment as needed.
- -Adding a full-time social worker to provide mental health care to help children and families cope with changes in their lives or family concerns.
- -Adding a testing coordinator to allow for Guidance Counselors to spend most of their time in direct service and contact with students.
- -Updated intercom system and speakers added to the inner and outer hallways.
- -Adding three school wide programs aimed at creating a school climate less susceptible to harassment, bullying and violence.

Westglades will continue to improve security measures, evaluate protocols, and train staff and students to keep our students safe.
