In order to qualify for Dual Enrollment courses, you must:

- Meet minimum scores from the ACT, SAT, FCAT, or PERT.
- Have a minimum 3.0 un-weighted GPA
- Have earned at least 11 credits.

<u>PERT = Postsecondary Education Readiness Test.</u> This test replaces the CPT (College Placement Test) as of March 2011. Selected Juniors will take the PERT in April, 2013 at Northeast High free of charge. Sophomores who qualify for Dual Enrollment may take the PERT at Broward College, but students must see their counselor in order to obtain the **PERT Test Form** that allows them to take the test without a fee.
