Kindergarten Dual Language Program



Country Isles Elementary launched its Dual Language Spanish Immersion Program in the 2016-2017 school year. Students in the innovative program spend fifty percent of the day fully immersed in the Spanish language. Instruction is delivered in all content areas in both languages. The program is currently open to kindergarten students who live within the school's boundaries with plans to expand every year by adding an additional grade level through the fifth grade. Currently, the Dual Language program is in grades K-5. Each Dual Language class is comprised of Spanish speakers and non-Spanish speakers. The goals and vision of the Dual Language Program are to produce college and career ready students.


- Kindergarten Criteria: 22/26 Letters and 18 Sounds
