Admissions

The College Academy accepts students from public, private, charter, and home schools who reside in Broward County. Ninety-nine percent of those who begin their pursuits at CA successfully completed their studies. Eligibility criteria included:

- Registered as a 10th grader at time of application
- Earned a minimum cumulative unweighted 3.25 GPA
- Earned high school credit (B or better) or currently enrolled in the following courses or comparable courses
 - English I & II
 - Algebra I & II
 - Science
 - World History
 - HOPE or equivalent
- Exemplary attendance, conduct, grades, and behavioral history at the time of application
- Pass all sub-tests of the Postsecondary Education Readiness Test (PERT) or SAT/ACT
 - PERT
 - Reading Comprehension 106+
 - Writing 103+
 - Math 114+
