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SCHOOL: The College Academy at Broward College (CA) is a public school, which opened in August 2001 as a joint venture between the School Board of Broward County and the Broward College Board of Trustees. CA is located on the Central and North campuses of Broward College. CA prides itself on its nurturing environment, small school setting, beautiful campuses, and its focus on student achievement. The program is designed for students who have the maturity required for college campus life, the discipline to use their time wisely, and the academic ability to handle the rigor of college work.

ENROLLMENT: CA enrolls students who reside in Broward County. Our students come from public and private schools. Eligibility criteria can be found on the school website: <http://collegeacademy.browardschools.com>. More than 99% of those who begin their pursuits at CA successfully complete their studies. The school population is diverse and reflects the religious, ethnic, and cultural background of the community. Current student demographics: Asian – 10%; Black – 21%; Hispanic – 31%; Indian – 0%; Multiracial – 4%; White – 34%. Thirty-six percent of students qualify for Free/Reduced Lunch.

FACULTY: 100% have Masters or Doctorate degrees; 50% are National Board Certified; all are qualified adjunct dual enrollment instructors. Faculty and staff provide an educational bridge, helping students transition from high school to college via tutoring, mentoring, and seminars.

SCHOOL YEAR:

CA has adopted the Broward College calendar:

- Winter Term (16 weeks);
- Spring Term (16 weeks);
- Summer Term A (6 weeks);

ACCREDITATION: CA and Broward College are accredited by AdvancED.

SBBC/COLLEGE PARTNERSHIP:

Students receive free tuition, fees, and textbooks. Transportation is available for eligible students. Students have access to all Broward College facilities, including computer and science laboratories and state-of-the-art

libraries. CA students are eligible to enroll in the BC



PROGRAM: CA is a Broward County Public Schools full-time dual enrollment (DE) collegiate high school. CA students take DE courses each term with CA credentialed instructors and BC professors. Most CA graduates are accepted to their upper-division college or university as first time college students with "junior" standing.
