

## GEARING UP FOR THE FALL 2021 PSAT!

In September, our school launched a school-wide initiative to assist our juniors as they prepare for the **October 16<sup>th</sup> PSAT**. This exam is the qualifying exam for National Merit Scholarships. Students who excel on the PSAT will be among approximately 32,000 students nationally who will have the opportunity to compete for millions of dollars in scholarships. As part of our Friday CARES offerings, each of our professors



offers an hour-long session that covers important strategies and practice questions. Both verbal and mathematics strategies are addressed in eight different intensive classes. Students learn verbal strategies such as SQ3R and detecting detractor questions. Mathematics strategies include assistance with rhetoric, algebraic thinking and problem solving and data analysis.

Students have shared that the sessions help them prepare for college entrance exams as well as their current college courses.

Students on both the north and central campuses participated in National No One Eats Alone Day on Thursday, September 23<sup>rd</sup>. Our learning community gathered to participate in a variety of activities such as charades, exploring music genres, chatting with subject area professors and just getting to know one another during lunchtime.
