

Volunteer Service Hours - Basic Information

- Summit Hours to:
 - o Central Campus Dr. Weinstein in Bldg. 2
 - North Campus Ms. Davis in Bldg. 47
- 40 hours of volunteer service are required for high school graduation
- Bright Future Scholarships has a volunteer requirement; 100 hours are required for the Academic Scholars Award and 75 hours are required for the Scholars Award
- To graduate with the volunteer service silver cord, 250+ hours required

- Volunteer hours must be done for a nonprofit organization; the only exceptions are hospitals, animal hospitals, retirement homes and preschools
- An approval form must be completed for each organization. The only exception is if you volunteer for your current school
- Check <u>www.handsonbroward.org</u> for a listing of pre-approved organizations
- All hours must be documented on the appropriate forms
- All volunteer service forms are available in Building 2 or 47, on the CA website and on-line at <u>www.browardschools.com</u>
- Deadline for <u>seniors</u> to submit hours for Silver Cords is in April
- Please submit completed hours in a timely fashion: monthly, each semester, etc.
