SOUTH PLANTATION HIGH SCHOOL STUDENT PARKING CONTRACT 2023-2024

The School Board of Broward County and South Plantation High School will not be held responsible for theft or damage to vehicles while parked on premises or leased lots. Any vandalism should be reported to school authorities and Police.

School parking decals are a privilege. Students who are eligible may be granted parking privileges on a first-come, first-serve basis. Parking permits will be offered only to students who have no outstanding financial obligations left from the previous or current year. Students involved in Dual Enrollment, Student Government and HOSA programs will be given priority to purchase a parking permit. Second priority will be given to senior students (17 or more credits with a minimum 2.0 GPA) on a first-come, first-serve basis. There will be no temporary parking on campus during the school year.

Students must show proof of the following before a decal will be issued:

- 1. A valid Florida operator's license -- not a restricted
- 2. Current Florida vehicle registration in the name of the student or parent/guardian.
- 3. Current insurance coverage is required by the State of Florida on the car parked on campus.
- 4. License plate tag number of one vehicle.
- 5. The parking fee is \$60.00 and must be paid with the **online payment system** at https://www.browardschools.com/Page/74602
- 6. Parking privileges may be denied if the vehicle is not in safe operating condition.

Listed below are the rules which must be followed for parking/driving on campus:

- THE DECAL MAY NOT BE TRANSFERRED TO ANOTHER VEHICLE. If a decal is found on a vehicle other
 than the one for which it was issued, the decal will be confiscated, and parking privileges will be rescinded
 permanently.
- 2. Vehicles will not be admitted to the student lot unless the parking decal is displayed on the **front windshield**.
- 3. Student parking is restricted to the student parking lots. Students must park in designated parking spaces in the specific lot assigned. No student parking is allowed in the faculty lot, visitor lot or the front of the school.
- 4. Any student parked on the campus illegally will be subject to towing at the owner's expense.
- 5. Temporary Parking Decals must be obtained from Mr. Hankerson and displayed on the dashboard prior to parking an alternative vehicle on campus. Registration and Insurance for that vehicle must be provided when applying for this decal. You can only get 1 temporary pass not to exceed 10 days.
- 6. Vehicles are to be kept locked.
- 7. Vehicles parked on campus may not be used for social purposes or as lockers. Sitting in cars during school hours is prohibited. Students are to leave cars immediately upon parking and leave the parking area. Students are **NOT** to be in the parking lot during or between classes without administrative approval. Any student leaving the parking lot during the day must be on a valid roster of an off-campus program or have been signed out in student affairs.
- 8. Any student who operates a vehicle in an unsafe manner or who is found in possession of alcohol or drugs on campus will have their parking privileges rescinded **permanently**.
- 9. Excessive tardiness, class cuts, GPA drop below 2.0, or the violation of Student Code of Conduct rules may result in parking privileges being rescinded.
- 10. There are no replacement parking decals.
- 11. The SPEED LIMIT IN PARKING LOTS AND ON CAMPUS IS 5 M.P.H.
- 12. School Board Personnel have the right to search any vehicle parked on school grounds.
- NOTE: 2023-2024 Parking Permit may be rescinded as a result of Administrative Action. Due to the demand for student parking at South Plantation, parking regulations must be strictly enforced. Suspension of parking privileges, additional disciplinary action, including suspension from school, may occur when parking regulations are violated.
