Administrative Report:

Principal Fried thanked all SAC members for coming in person and those that were online. Shout out to our new PTSA President for her commitment to The Bay and all the gestures of kindness that have been done for our faculty and staff. The collaboration amongst the new board and Cypress is truly remarkable. Discussed the success of the administration of the PSAT where 900 students came to our campus to test. On March 3rd we will be administering the SAT to all our 11th graders. This is not a super test day, it will be an instructional day. Testing team is in the process to construct a plan to organize proctors, as well as a solid plan for the safety of the students and teachers. Seniors will be participating in a College and Career prep. Lots of testing is coming up EOC's, FSA's, AICE and A.P.'s. The goal is

that we can accomplish these high stake tests in a safe and orderly fashion. One of the lessons learned is that we shall be doing a staggered dismissal. The county is providing the funds to run intervention camps that will run afterschool and on Saturdays. Putting the finishing touches on our events for our Seniors. Cypress is working with the City Manager and Mayor to make sure that we can repeat the success of last year's Senior Parade. Commissioner MacFie asked about posting a communication piece, so that we to let community know about what is coming up for the seniors. We are awaiting more information from the district as far as parameters are concerned. We do know that the window for graduation will be June 4th through June 10th.

Budget Requests:
