

Art Enrichment Program



"Meet the Masters" is a volunteer Art History and Art Appreciation program intended to introduce children with the world of art- and we need parent volunteers for each classroom. "Meet the Masters" increases interest in art by exposing children to selected prints (approved by the Broward School Board) and is facilitated by parent volunteers who have an enthusiasm for bringing fine art to the students. Volunteers schedule with their assigned teacher to come into the classroom and make presentations on the lives and works of 2 master artists. If the teacher allows you can even follow your presentation with an art project to engage the students to practice what they learned. These presentations, using reproductions of the artists' works, usually last about 30 minutes to one hour depending on the amount of time the teacher allows. You can use large posters provided or use the prints available on line to show in the classroom. "Meet the Masters" promotes an awareness of arts in our community and is a great way to watch firsthand how it impacts students in the classroom. Please be advised that EVERYONE must show picture identification when entering the office for any transaction. This includes, but is not limited to, signing a child out, conferences, meetings, to collect paperwork, and volunteer opportunities. Peanut/Nut Allergies:

We currently have students at the school with severe peanut/nut allergies. It is important that there is a strict avoidance to this food in order to prevent a life threatening allergic reaction. We are asking your help to provide the students with a safe school environment. To reduce the chance of this occurring we ask that you do not send any peanut or nut containing products to school with your child. If your child has eaten peanuts/nuts before coming to school, please be sure your child's hands and face have been washed thoroughly before entering school.



School Lunch:

Per district policy and federal regulations, students are only allowed one charged meal per year. Our school will not provide a charge account backup. Parents may put money in student accounts in person before 8 am on school days or online via our website.

School Safety:

We ask that everyone be cooperative with staff as we work to maximize our security and traffic procedures.

Please adhere to the following procedures:

- Please make sure your child and their teacher know how they're going home daily, starting on the first day of school.
- Enter and exit through the front office only for all visits. To account for everyone on campus, we need everyone to sign in AND out through the office at every visit.
- All identification badges must be worn on the upper body so that staff can easily determine who has been cleared through the office.
- Do not ask students or staff to open side doors or gates.
- Do not exit vehicles in the car loop during arrival or dismissal.
- Be friendly but do not engage staff in conversations during arrival and dismissal. They are working to supervise their assigned areas.
- Student sign outs must be before 1:30 p.m.
- Parking gates will be locked shortly after the bell and will not re-open until just before dismissal. During school hours, visitors may park BRIEFLY in the bus loop (8:30 1:30 only), or in the park and walk around.
- Do not park in the small lot behind the cafeteria.
- Do not park in the staff parking lot on the east side of the school.

- Do not park in the grass, driveways or swales of neighbor yards.
- Obey speed signs and do not use cell phones.
- Use crosswalks & obey crossing guards.
- Do not bring dogs on campus.
- Be patient.
