- ✓ Clubs start in April. They will take place every Monday from 4/4/22 thru
 5/23/22 beginning at 2:00pm and ending promptly at 3:10pm. All clubs
 meet at the same time.
- ✓ Each club will cost \$90 for 8 sessions. This is a non-refundable payment that
 is due by 2/11/22.
- ✓ There is a 10% discount for children of School Board employees, students
 currently in Parkside aftercare, OR for each sibling after the first that is
 registered at the full rate (Choose the 10% option in the E-Store).
- ✓ Students must be picked up in the car loop **promptly at 3:10.** There are no walkers or bike riders since there aren't any crossing guards at that time.

How to register:

- 1. Visit **www.browardschools.com/parkside** and click on the link for Panther Pastimes. Follow the instructions carefully!
- 2. Decide which club you would like to join and any discounts you qualify for.
- 3. Make a payment through the E-Store.
- 4. After payment, you must return to the Panther Pastimes home page and <u>fill</u> out <u>ALL</u> of the information on the registration form. For security reasons, your child can't participate in a club unless they are registered!
