Improper drying, wet nesting of equipment/utensils (quarter pans) after sanitization. Clean and sanitize equipment/utensils. Corrected onsite, items were cleaned and sanitized prior to air drying.

EcoLab SmartPower sanitizer concentration level measured 848 PPM in manual operation (3 comp. sink). Manufacturer's specification requires concentration of 272 - 700 PPM. Provide sanitizer level according to manufacturer specification. Corrected onsite, solution later tested to 700 ppm.
