

Attendance/Tardiness

Regular attendance is important to ensure successful and positive growth.

A phone call or written note directly to our office is required on the day of or immediately following any child's absence to be excused. Please do not use the student agenda as a means of communication with the main office regarding your child's absence. The agenda is a means of communication between the teacher and parent.

If your child is ill and an absence is expected over a period of time, please notify the front office 7544-323-7000.

Students arriving to school after 8:01 a.m. are considered tardy. All students tardy minutes are recorded and monitored.

Please be aware that five or more absences or tardies will result in an automatic referral to Administration, the School Social Worker, and the Broward Truancy Intervention Program (BTIP). BTIP is monitored by the State of Florida's State Attorney's Office.
