Appropriate dress helps create a positive learning environment. Pembroke Pines Elementary School has a mandatory Uniform (Unified Dress Code) Policy. Students are expected to wear their school uniform each and every school day, including Fridays. Other attire may be permitted for special school activities or events, with approval from school administration. Below is a brief description of our Uniform (Unified Dress Code) Policy:

TOPS: forest green or navy collared (polo) shirts or PPE school t-shirts.

Tank tops, spaghetti straps, or other revealing tops, such as those that expose the torso, are not allowed.

BOTTOMS: skirts/skortts, shorts, or pants in solid navy, tan/khaki or denim.

Bottoms must be worn appropriately fastened or secured at waist level. Bottoms exposing the upper thigh are not allowed.

FOOTWEAR: sneakers are recommended.

Students may not wear backless, sling-backs, or open-toed footwear. Slippers/flip-flops are also not allowed.

Please make sure your child's attire is in compliance with our Unified Dress Code Policy. Failure to comply with this policy will result in one or more of the following: a parent conference, time out, loss of privilege or extra-curricular activities, removal from class, and/or detention (in accordance with the SBBC Code of Student Conduct).
