\*All excused student absences must align with the eight (8) reasons allowed for absences, as outlined in the Attendance Policy and Code of Student Conduct.

## APPROVED REASONS FOR ABSENCES

STUDENTS MUST BE IN SCHOOL UNLESS THE ABSENCE HAS BEEN PERMITTED OR EXCUSED FOR ONE OF THE REASONS LISTED BELOW:

1. ILLNESS OF STUDENT 2. ILLNESS OF AN IMMEDIATE FAMILY MEMBER 3. DEATH IN THE FAMILY 4. RELIGIOUS HOLIDAY 5. REQUIRED COURT APPEARANCE OR SUBPOENA 6. SPECIAL EVENT 7. SCHEDULED MEDICAL OR DENTAL APPOINTMENT 8. STUDENT HAS A COMMUNICABLE DISEASE FORTIFY

FortifyFL is a suspicious activity reporting tool that allows you to instantly relay information to appropriate law enforcement agencies and school officials.

# **UNIFORM POLICY**

Fox Trail is a unified dress code school. Bottoms may be shorts (not gym-type shorts), slacks (not leggings), skirts or skorts and should be solid navy-blue, black, or khaki and may be worn with white, gold, royal blue, or navy-blue polo shirts. Additionally, Fox Trail t-shirts purchased through PTSA may be worn. Fox Trail club and class tshirts may ONLY be worn on Fridays. Shoes must be closed toed and heeled. No Crocs.
