Parking Lot Etiquette

We ask for your assistance in making the parking lot a safe place for our students and their families.

*Please cross your child at the designated crosswalks, do not send them on their own.

*When using the car loop, please pull up so we can fit more cars in the unloading area. Your child can exit their car anywhere along the car loop after you pass the bike rack. It is not necessary to pull all the way to the front to unload.

*Children should be prepared to exit the vehicle when you stop, and adults are asked to remain in their vehicle while in the car loop.

We appreciate your assistance in helping our parking lot run smoothly. Drop off supervision begins at 7:30. Students should arrive between 7:30 and 7:55 am so all students can be in their classroom for the 8:00 bell and they can promptly start their day.

Remember if it's 8:00... You are LATE!

Arrival and Dismissal

Please refrain from picking students up before 2:00pm. Students are learning up until the end of the day and may miss important instruction.

When dropping and picking up students, please stay in your car and hang your sign on the mirror for an easy and quicker car line.
