Thank you for an amazing start to the school year! It brings us great joy to see your children in our classrooms. Please join me in giving a huge shout out to teachers; they have been remarkable this first month of school and have been working relentlessly to ensure your student has the best possible experience for this school year. I'd also like to give a big shout out to our students and their families for everything they do to make Fox Trail such a great place to be! We appreciate our PTSA and our volunteers that are always eager to support our school.

The month of September was filled with reviewing expectations, practicing routines and completing diagnostic assessments like iReady and BAS. As a Leader in Me school, we have been reviewing the 7 Habits that will promote student independence and leadership.

The month of October brings us pumpkins, candy and lots of learning at Fox Trail. Our students have been busy exploring our new reading series. Instead of traditional textbooks, this series uses units in a magazine format. They will be sent home at the end of each unit so your children will have them to practice with and reread at home. We encourage our students to read for pleasure every day. Research, from Scholastic Reading, shows that students who read just 25 minutes a day were likely to score in the 80 percentile or above on reading exams and are exposed to 1,697,00 words per year!

Please have your child bring a refillable water bottle to school with them every day. We have filling stations throughout the school for the students to refill bottles.


Lost and Found

Invitation to Participate in Community Meetings on Broward County Public Schools Redistricting Process

Dear Resident:

In 2021, Broward County Public Schools, like all other school districts in Florida, must redraw its single-member school districts to account for changes in population since the last decennial census. Redistricting is the process of drawing boundaries for political districts to account for population shifts. Redistricting of School Board Member Voting Districts DOES NOT impact student attendance boundaries or transportation.

Broward County Public Schools selected Florida International University (FIU) as its consultant for the redistricting process. FIU is conducting an open and transparent process utilizing current, generally accepted methods and standards for the development of redistricting plans. Public input is key to the effort.

You are invited to attend any one of four community meetings to obtain information about the process and to provide input. If you are unable to attend one of the onsite meetings in person, we invite you to participate in the virtual meeting.


