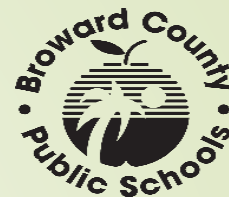

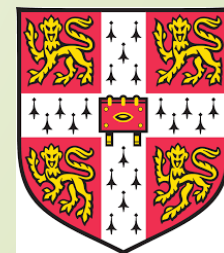

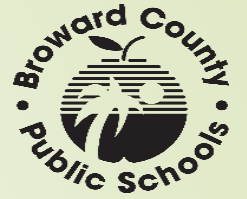

- Please consider your choices carefully. Every effort will be made to grant students their choices, however, **a student's request for a specific elective is not guaranteed**.



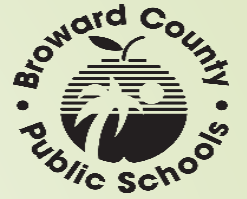

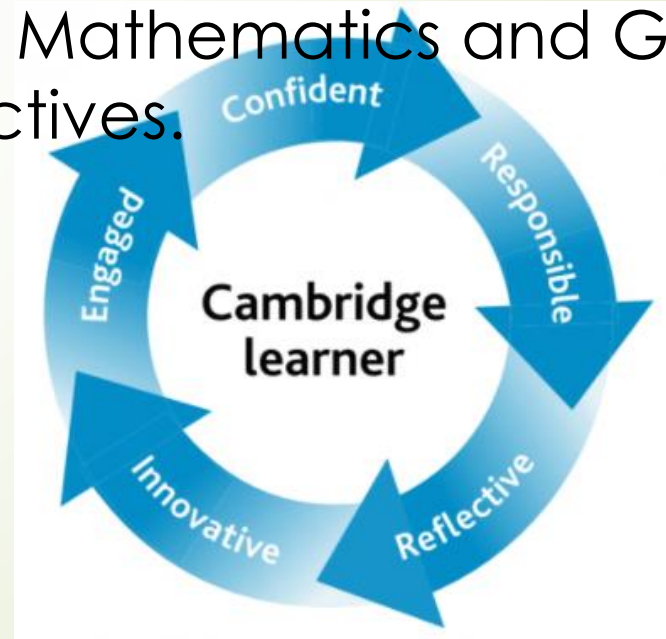


What is the Cambridge Program?

The SSMS Cambridge courses prepare students for the rigor and research requirements of the Cambridge program at Coral Glades HS.

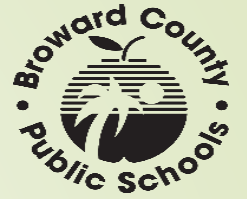
Did you know....

At Coral Glades HS, Cambridge students fulfill a minimum of seven college level courses/examinations. Here at SSMS, we

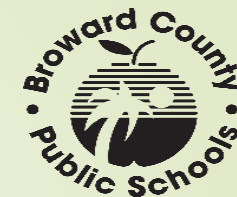
