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

If you are not accepted into the magnet program

- Magnet Schools usually have a 2nd and 3rd lottery (phase 2 and 3) until their program is filled. You can wait it out. DO NOT re-apply to the same school.
- □ You are welcome to change your "1st choice" to one that has availability. (Phase 2 or 3))
- □ You can contact the Demographics Office for further guidance. (See web page)







- Broward College is licensed by the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) to offer all of the training you need
 to earn the two licenses you will need in order to work in the field: -Airframe Mechanic -Powerplant Mechanic
- Upon completion of the program you will have the right to be tested for a FAA Airframe and/or Powerplant Certificate.
- If you choose to go further in the Aviation industry, then the completion of the certificate programs may convert into college credit (30 credits per license) toward an Associate in Applied Science degree in Aviation Maintenance Management.
- Aviation Maintenance is an exacting profession with little room for error. If you like to work with your hands and your brain, are repair minded, detail oriented and willing to learn complex technical systems then this may be the field for you!
