Advanced Placement and Dual Enrollment

In 2018, 830 CCHS students took over 1326 AP tests in 24 subjects, and 63% scored 3 or higher. Also, 14 students received an AP Capstone Diploma. In 2018, 228 students took Dual Enrollment courses and 24 students were Early Admission students at Broward College, Florida Atlantic University and University of Florida.
