Academic Focus

During the months of February and March we will be working on the following skills:

Reading/Language Arts- Unit 6 focuses on literature as students read realistic fiction stories and learn how characters' actions have consequences that impact the story. Grammar and writing will continue to focus on using nouns, verbs, adjectives, adverbs, and subordinate clauses correctly in our writing.

Math- Topics 10-12 will focus on Fractions, Comparing Fractions and Graphing. So much fun!

Science- We will be using a variety of texts, resources, and projects to learn about Friction and Law of Gravity.

Social Studies- Our focus during these months will be Government. Students will also learn about Martin Luther King, Jr., people and events of Black History month, and presidential facts as we celebrate Presidents' Day.
