

# Reading

Students will take the FAST PM3 test in Reading on May 7<sup>th</sup>. In reading they have been busy reading about the Transcontinental Railroad, Earth Changes, and Resources and their impact. Please continue to encourage your child to do their two i-Ready lessons to achieve their goal of 30-45 minutes of i-Ready Reading per week to help reinforce the4th grade reading benchmarks.

#### **Science**

Our 4th grade scientists will be learning about plants' and animals' impact on their environment, energy in a food chain, forms of energy, and resources in Florida. We also have the Gabi Bus field trip, on April 30th, to learn more about those topics.

## **Writing**

The students took the writing test in the beginning of April. They will continue to work on answering questions in complete sentences and improving their writing skills with 4 and 5 paragraph essays.
