Reading

Students took the 2nd FAST test this past December and the 2nd Diagnostic test for i-Ready in January. Please make sure you have seen the data from those tests to have an idea of where your child is in reading. In reading they have been busy reading about technology and its impact on society and about how characters confront challenges. Also please continue to encourage your child to do their two i-Ready lessons to achieve their goal of 30-45 minutes of i-Ready Reading per week.

Math

Please make sure they continue to use Fluency Flight on i-Ready to help with fluency and they need to do 2 lessons a week in Math as well.
