- IV. School Improvement Plan, Mid Year Reflection
 - a. School goal is to hit 80% proficiency in 3-5 grades by the end of the year. We are on track to hit that goal, based on iReady data.
- V. Data
 - a. Students took the iReady Diagnostic and should be mid or above grade level. All grade levels made significant jumps in their proficiency in both reading and math.
 - b. To help make sure we reach our goal, there is PD ongoing, walk throughs, clubs, differentiated instruction based on reading levels, monitoring data and tailored interventions.
- VI. Progress Monitoring Parent Communication
 - a. Any students on a PMP will receive a monthly letter about interventions, and whether or not they are making progress. If a letter isn't sent, there needs to be a conference.
 - b. To help our lower performing students, we will use targeted interventions, increasing collaboration between ESE and ESL teachers, continuing discussions on data, PLCs, supporting staff supporting students in small groups.
- VII. Attendance Letters
 - a. The attendance letters that went home on red paper are for students who missed 10% or more of school so far. This is for excused and unexcused absences.
