If they come to school and present with any COVID related symptoms, they may be sent home for 10 days. So if they are not feeling well, please keep them home.
- Finally thank you to everyone - the students who have been consistently wearing masks, learning proper spacing in and around school, those students at home who are actively engaged in their daily learning and to the teachers who have learned how to teach in two different arenas at the same time—teaching student that are in school and at home.
