Topic	Rules and Procedures
Learning Modality	<p>Students in face to face learning (in school) may elect to transition back to eLearning at any time. Please tell your child's teacher before doing this so your child will be coded properly for attendance. However, students in eLearning must contact the school to check for availability based on room capacity before they can transition back to the physical classroom. They must remain in eLearning until contacted by the school.</p>
Before School	<p>Parents are asked to encouraged to ask these questions each morning before sending your child to school.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Does my child have a fever or elevated temperature (100.4) or the chills? • Does my child have a persistent cough, runny nose or sore throat? • Has my child recently had a loss of taste of smell? • Has anyone in my household tested positive for COVID-19? • Has my child been in close unprotected contact with anyone who has tested positive for COVID-19? (spent longer than 15 min. Within 6' of someone who is sick with a fever or cough or confirmed /suspected case of COVID-19?) • Is my child feeling otherwise sick or ill today? • Is my child been tested for or awaiting test results for COVID-19? • Has my child tested positive for COVID 19? • Has my child been told to self-quarantine by a doctor? <p>If the answer to any of these is yes, the child is to stay home.</p>
Arrival	<p>Students must arrive and be in class no later than the 8:00 bell. Students may get a Grab & Go breakfast upon entering as long as they are on campus before the 8:00 bell. Students will, if interested in eating breakfast campus, will take a Grab & Go breakfast then proceed to their classroom. Students arriving after the 8:00 bell will go straight to class.</p>
Masks	<p>Facial coverings must be worn at all times while on campus and on school buses. Face coverings should cover both nose and mouth and fit snugly on both sides of the face with no gaps. Masks may be taken off to eat and during physical activity when physical distancing is in place. If students deliberately do not abide with the facial</p>

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	covering policy after several warnings, parents will be contacted. For the safety of the students and the staff, those students may be transitioned back to eLearning at home.
Materials	<p>Students returning to school should bring all materials needed to learn in class. This includes all books and supplies given out in the beginning of the year, school issued laptop/device and headphones. These items will remain on campus. Please send a chapter book or other appropriate reading material for your student to read throughout the day. We ask that you send your child with a water bottle since water fountains will not be accessible for students due to health and safety concerns associated with students drinking from the same fountain. General drinking fountains are being retrofitted with water bottle filling devices so students can safely refill their water bottles during the day. Until this installation is complete, please send them with water daily.</p> <p>Students may bring their own hand sanitizer and/or wipes to class.</p>
Food	<p>For those students remaining in eLearning, Food distributions will still be available Tuesdays and Thursdays from 11:00-1:00 by driving through the school's bus loop. The same requirements apply: Must have a student ID, passport, report card or birth certificate to verify students' identity. Food will only be given to students who are continuing with eLearning.</p> <p>For those students returning to school, Breakfast will be provided free to all students throughout the school year. Lunch will be provided free of charge to all students until December 2020.</p>
Uniforms	<p>At this time, uniforms are not mandatory but are highly encouraged. Students must however adhere to the Broward County Dress Code. Administration will follow the Discipline Matrix for any student/s not following the SBBC dress code.</p>
Dismissal	<p>Car riders: will be picked up in the car loop, gate to opens at 1:50PM. Please have the Orange student card on your dashboard to help us call names and remove the need for you to roll down your window.</p> <p>Walkers: Will be dismissed by grade level through the walker gate. Due to social distance mandates, we WILL NOT be holding any students to wait for their parent at the gate. Parents meeting</p>

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	students at the walkers' gate will need to be there by 2:00. ALL students will be dismissed out the gate at 2:00.
Staff	There may be times and unforeseen circumstances where a teacher is not available to teach from campus. Please be assured your child will be monitored by Lake Forest staff and continued to be instructed on the Florida Standards.
Visitors	Visitors to Lake Forest must call for an appointment to access the campus. Please call the front office at 754-323-6350 to schedule an appointment if needed. No parent volunteers will be allowed in the classroom at this time. There will be no deliveries of items to students during the school day. (Ex. Jackets, backpacks, lunch, snacks...) Please make sure they have what they need before they come to school.
