1. Please read all forms carefully, complete all information, and sign where requested.
2. The EL2 must be filled out by an approved physical examiner.
3. Proof of health insurance must accompany these forms; an attached photo-copy.
4. Any incomplete forms may result in the delay of allowing your child to participate.



South Plantation Player/Parent/ Coach Contract

1. Athletics and activities are a privilege and any violation of the rules be a player or parent may result in the loss of these privileges.
2. All forms must be filled out and completed in full.
3. Rules regarding student eligibility are followed according to the rules set forth by the FHSAA.
4. All equipment and uniforms purchased via SPHS accounts or booster accounts will be considered property of SPHS Athletics.
5. SPHS Athletics will take precedents over other activities and clubs in school or in the private sector. In the event there is a conflict the athlete must inform the head coach in writing with-in 10 days of the event.
6. Players and parents are encouraged to do fundraising. Failure to participate in fundraising may result in the athlete not receiving benefit from the fundraiser.
7. Parents are expected to support the athlete/team in all aspects. Good sportsmanship is mandatory in the stands. Parents will not taunt the officials, opponents, or coaching staff.
8. Athlete and Parent concerns must be brought to the head coach immediately. It is expected that the athlete/parent will contact the head coach and make an appointment to discuss concerns and find a resolution. At no time may an athlete or parent go above the head coach with concerns without first meeting with the head coach.
9. Chain of command in dealing with concerns. Athlete/parent meet with head coach, then athlete/parent meet with Athletic Director, then athlete/ parent meet with AP over athletics, then athlete / parent meet with principal.
10. Parents should not discuss tactics, training, or situations of other athletes with coaches.
11. Varsity level is expected to play the athletes that can win the game; at all times. There is no guarantee of playing time.
12. JV level is for development and is intended for all athletes to participate, even if it will result in a loss.
13. Coaches may never handle money and may result in termination.
14. Coaches will be responsible for all aspects of the game including off-season workouts, preseason, paperwork, Max Preps, Home Campus Data, Video, player development, social media, reporting game results, keeping accurate statics, transportation, uniforms, gear, facilities, game set up and clean up, pregame, and end of year recognition of athletes.
15. Coaches are expected to further their personal development by joining FACA or any other coaches' organization for their primary sport.

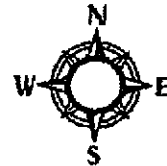
