Harvard University considers this next Hispanic in STEM as the next Albert Einstein. Sabrina Gonzalez Pasterski is a 24 year old physicist who has a very impressive resume that rivals any experienced physicist of our time. Currently Ms. Pasterski studies black holes and spacetime to explain gravity within the context of quantum mechanics. She has also been cited by Stephen Hawking and Andrew Strominger.
Linda Garcia Cubero is an engineer and the first Hispanic female to graduate from the Air Force Academy. In 1980 she graduated with a bachelor's in Political Science. From there she was commissioned to the Air Force as a second lieutenant and then began pursuing a master's in systems engineering from Virginia Tech. In 1998, Cubero was awarded the Women of Color Technology Award, while being inducted into the National Hispanic Engineering Hall of Fame
