	All classes will be invited to visit the Harvest Drive on the special event days to walk-thru the gym.
	Art & Peer Counseling will create Harvest banners to be hung throughout the school.
	NJHS, Women's Power, FFEA, Peer Counseling, and Yearbook students will decorate Harvest cards for our families. (<i>Week of November 4-8</i>)
	Yearbook/Morning Announcements will take pictures, make announcements about weekly collections, place in Yearbook, create a video, etc
	NJHS, Girl Power, FFEA, Peer Counseling, and Yearbook will decorate bags using die-cuts, stencils, etc
	Students/Staff will participate in a school-wide spirit day by wearing a Harvest Color (orange, brown, green, yellow, and/or red) or a Harvest t-shirt. (<i>TH</i> , 11/14)
	Students will receive an <i>I Harvested</i> sticker when visiting the Harvest Drive in the gym.
	Peer Counselors will conduct Harvest speeches to get everyone excited and involved.
	Bi-weekly, a Peer Counselor will stop by all classrooms to collect food.
