- Yearbook/Morning Announcements** will take pictures, make announcements about weekly collections, place in Yearbook, create a video, etc..
- NJHS, Women's Power, FFEA, Peer Counseling, and Yearbook** students will decorate Harvest cards for our families. (*Week of November 4-8*)
- Art & Peer Counseling** will create Harvest banners to be hung throughout the school.
- All classes** will be invited to visit the Harvest Drive on the special event days to walk-thru the gym.
- All Peer Counselors & 7th Grade Cambridge ELA students (McMahon) will participate in the 3 day event during their specified period only.
- 12 NJHS Captains will attend each day and act as a lead captain throughout the day.
