We also added a Math Fluency Lab to our specials rotation to help our learners acquire those foundational skills in mathematics. This year, we are fully implementing Florida's B.E.S.T (Benchmark for Excellent Student Thinking) standards while continuing our tradition of high achievement for all learners. In addition to our internal assessments, we will administer Florida's F.A.S.T (Florida Assessment of Student Thinking) assessment to students in VPK through grade 5 to monitor their academic progress.
