FEATURING WORK BY MRS. ORTIZ'S ART STUDENTS

Renowned for their resourcefulness, speed, and creativity, a group of African-American Florida artists known as the Highwaymen employed a unique painting style as a way to assert their economic independence and agency during and after the segregation era.

Developing a new type of art in the process, these 26 artists, including one woman, made careers by depicting the richness and variety of Florida's landscapes. The group began in the 1950s, but their emotive works still resonate today.

In recognition of Black History Month, the GMS art students created landscape art inspired by the paintings of the

Florida Highwaymen.


