Character: Do What is Right!

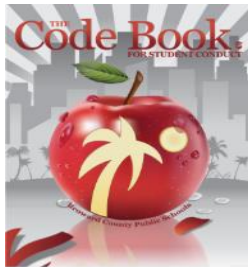

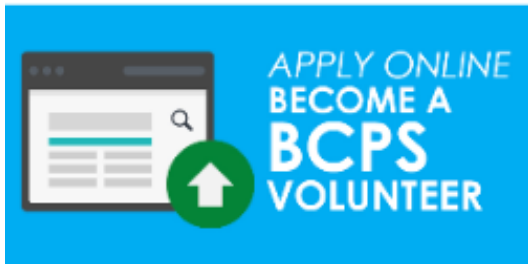

Meal Services

New Renaissance is happy to announce it will operate under the Community Eligibility Provision or (CEP) for the 2022-2023 school year. The provision is available to schools participating in the National School Lunch and School Breakfast Programs with 40% or more students receiving SNAP, TANF or Extension of Benefits.

This means all students enrolled at New Renaissance Middle School are eligible to receive FREE Breakfast and Lunch this school year.

Transportation Services

The department of pupil transportation will mail bus passes to all students eligible for transportation services during the first two weeks of August. To be eligible for transportation services you must live two (2) or more miles away from the school. Students that live under two (2) miles do not qualify for transportation services.

Students eligible for transportation will need to register to ride. After completing the online registration a bus pass will be available on Virtual Counselor, as soon as possible. Student Transportation & Fleet Services will be hosting an "Open House" on Saturday, August 13, 2022, from 10 a.m. - 2 p.m., and on Sunday, August 14, 2022, from 1 - 5 p.m.

Campus Safety



Broward County Public Schools has implemented districtwide safety and security measures that must be followed by all schools. These district mandated security enhancements will be strictly reinforced throughout the school year.

Student Identification Badges

All students and staff are required to wear identification badges while on campus at all times. Students will be provided an ID badge during the first two weeks of school. Lost student identification badges must be replaced. Students that fail to comply with the identification badge policy will be issued disciplinary consequences.

Campus Visitors

All visitors must enter and exit the campus through the RAPTOR system located in the Welcome Center. Once processed in the RAPTOR system visitors will be provided a school issued form of identification that must be visible while on campus.

NRMS Unified Dress Code

New Renaissance Middle School (NRMS) is a unified dress code school. Students are expected to follow the dress code policy. Failure to comply with the unified dress code policy will result in disciplinary consequences.

Student Arrivals and Dismissal

Students will be in classes from 9:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. When arriving late to school, students must check in at the Welcome Center and will be issued a tardy pass to class. Parents must sign students into school at the Welcome Center for a tardy to be considered excused. Parents may sign students out of school early until 3:30 p.m. **Student supervision is provided from 9:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Students cannot arrive on campus before 9:00 a.m. and students must be picked up by 4:30 p.m.** Parents choosing to drive their child to school must use the car loop for student drop off and pick up at the appropriate times. Please do not drop off student at Ansin Park or on Miramar Boulevard.

What happens if students lose their ID?

Lost ID bages must be replaced as soon as possible. Replacement ID badges free up to 3 badges. After 3 replacements have been issued, a \$5.00 fee is applied.

Student Schedules

Seventh and Eighth Grade: 3:00 p.m.
