Teachers will post instructional activities and assignments to be completed for the week; students need to familiarize themselves with the week's expectations and plan their time accordingly.

Most of the resources that students need to access are on the Clever Launch

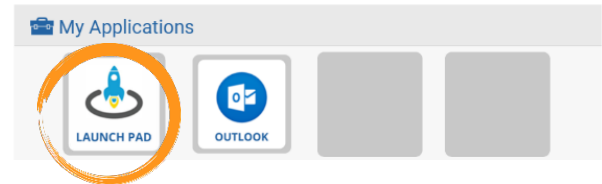

Students with a Personal (Not School Loaned) Laptop:

1. Open a web browser (chrome is preferred)
2. Go to sso.browardschools.com (bookmark this page)
3. Click "Log in with Active Directory"
4. Enter your student log in information
5. You should see your launch pad resources
6. *password resets – call BCPS ETS Department 754-321-0411*

Students with a School Loaned Laptop:

1. As soon as you log into the laptop, a web browser should open to: sso.browardschools.com
2. Click on the "Launch Pad" icon
3. You should see your launch pad resources
