



LYONS CREEK MIDDLE SCHOOL – TRAFFIC ISSUES

ATTENTION: Parents, guardians, caregivers, and anyone transporting children to and from Lyons Creek Middle School.

The Coconut Creek Police Department is responsible for ensuring the safety of all students and the community. However, the COVID-19 pandemic has presented several new traffic challenges throughout the 2021-2022 school year, due to a significant increase in vehicles transporting students.

This notice is intended to educate drivers on the types of actions that are contrary to Florida State Traffic Laws before the Coconut Creek Police Department is forced to conduct stricter enforcement. In order to maintain the safe flow of traffic, it is essential that everyone obeys the following stipulations:

- Lining up, parking or stopping of any kind on the roadway, prior to 4:00 PM, is strictly prohibited
- Do not block the intersections or any portion of the crosswalks in the area
- Do not block driveways
- Do not block exits/entrances to communities
- Do not enter neighboring residential communities or businesses to park, awaiting 4:00 PM dismissal time
- Do not park on the grass swales of neighboring communities. This practice leads to property damage
- Do not stop in the roadway to pick-up or drop-off students

**ANY VIOLATION OF FLORIDA STATE STATUTES WILL RESULT
