Park Trails Elementary is elated to announce that we will begin our (3rd session) afterschool Panther Clubs starting on Tuesday, February 18th! Panther Clubs is an Extended Learning Opportunities Program (ELOP) available through the partnership of ASP and Park Trails Elementary.

We regard the development and implementation of extracurricular activities and clubs as a positive and meaningful contribution to the lives of our students. A child's education does not take place only in the classroom, during regular school hours. Hence, school sponsored afterschool activities can be valuable setting for a child's continued personal and academic growth. Panther Clubs provides students with the following:

*Opportunities to develop socially through engaging activities which develop and strengthen character, leadership skills and social skills.

*Participation in multiple forms of co-curricular activities involving common interests of club members.

Days and Club Meetings

Panther Clubs will begin on Tuesday, February 18th and will meet between the hours of 2:45-3:45pm. Please see the club description and dates as each club has their own meeting schedule. Please write this down so that there is no confusion of club meeting dates.

Cost

8-week club session fees are \$140 per child. There is a 10% discount for siblings and students enrolled in ASP (e.g., Student A will pay \$140, and Sibling B pays \$126 per club). Fees will be collected once your child has registered and been accepted into their desired club. All steps must be delivered to the classroom teacher. Please place your child's completed form in an envelope labeled "ATTN: MRS. DURAN." Seats are limited! Once the club is full, no additional seats will be available. Clubs will be canceled if enrollment is low.

Please make sure to read and follow all registration steps:

1. **First**, register online at <https://www.browardschools.com/Page/66512> under "ELOP." **YOU WILL NOT PAY ON THIS SITE—THIS IS ONLY TO REGISTER YOUR CHILD. NO CASH, CHECKS OR MONEY ORDERS WILL BE ACCEPTED.** Complete EVERY section. Applications will not be accepted if any information is left blank.
2. Next, complete the Authorization form (front and back) and include your online registration confirmation number. Do not return your application without this confirmation number.
3. Lastly, due to limited seats in most of our clubs, all "completed" applications will be processed in the order they are received (first come, first served). Once you have been accepted into the club, you will receive information with instructions on how to pay.

Since club dates are established for the school year, if clubs are canceled due to district closures (e.g., hurricanes), it will be at the teacher's discretion to reschedule that session.

Ensure that all forms—both online and paper—are completed and submitted to qualify for a seat in the club. Completed applications will be prioritized; incomplete applications will be returned. **Additionally, online applications are not time-stamped, so registering early does NOT guarantee a seat.** We strongly encourage you to choose a backup club in case your child is not selected for their first choice.

All payments will be made online. The payment portal will be accessible once all applications have been processed (within 3-7 days). Please wait for further instructions before making any payments on the portal. We cannot provide refunds if you change your mind or if the club is canceled due to low enrollment.

Arrival & Dismissal

Students will be dismissed to ELOP Panther Clubs at 2:15 PM on their club meeting days. At 2:15, students will report to the cafeteria, where they will be supervised and given a snack until the club sponsors arrive at 2:45 PM.

Student pickup will be at 3:45 PM (back bus loop). Students who are in the ASP program will be dismissed back to the aftercare program once the club is over.

Each club will have a check-in system. Upon arrival, the paraprofessional will take attendance. Students will be released only to the adults listed on the student's Panther Club registration form.

Students who are not picked up by 3:45 PM at the end of the club session must be picked up from the office and will incur a late fee for tardiness. Parents will incur a \$15 late fee for the first instance and may be terminated from future sessions if tardiness occurs again. Please be on time! 😊

Afterschool Programs (ASP)

Please note that ELOP- Panther Clubs are separate from ASP. Both programs have separate fees. Parents who are not able to pick up their children from clubs by 3:45 may pay for their child to be placed in ASP, if seats are available. ASP is available until 6:00pm daily. If your child is currently enrolled in ASP, they will be given a 10% discount for each club. Once the club is over, your child will join their ASP groups.
