Park Trails Elementary is elated to announce that we will begin our (3<sup>rd</sup> session) afterschool Panther Clubs starting on Tuesday, September 3<sup>rd</sup>! Panther Clubs is an Extended Learning Opportunities Program (ELOP) available through the partnership of ASP and Park Trails Elementary.

We regard the development and implementation of extracurricular activities and clubs as a positive and meaningful contribution to the lives of our students. A child's education does not take place only in the classroom, during regular school hours. Hence, school sponsored afterschool activities can be valuable setting for a child's continued personal and academic growth. Panther Clubs provides students with the following:

\*Opportunities to develop socially through engaging activities which develop and strengthen character, leadership skills and social skills.

\*Participation in multiple forms of co-curricular activities involving common interests of club members.

**Days and Club Meetings**

Panther Clubs will begin on Tuesday, September 3<sup>rd</sup> and will meet between the hours of 2:45-3:45pm. Please see the club description and dates as each club has their own meeting schedule. Please write this down so that there is no confusion of club meeting dates.

**Cost**

8-week club sessions fees are \$140 per child. There is a 10% discount for siblings and students enrolled in ASP. (i.e Student **A** will pay \$140 and sibling **B** pays \$126 per club). Fees will be collected once your child has registered and has been accepted into their desired club. All steps must be delivered to the classroom teacher. Please place your child's completed form in an envelope "ATTN: MRS.DURAN." Seats are limited!! Once the club is full, no additional seats will be available. Clubs will be cancelled if enrollment is low.

**Please make sure to read and follow all registration steps.**

1. First, register online (Chrome Browser recommended) (<https://www.browardschools.com/Page/66512>) "ELOP"—YOU WILL NOT PAY ON THIS SITE—THIS IS ONLY TO REGISTER YOUR CHILD. **NO CHECKS/MONEY ORDERS WILL BE ACCEPTED.** Complete EVERY section. Applications will not be accepted if information is left blank.
2. Next, complete the Authorization form (front/back) and attach your online registration confirmation number. Do not return your application without your online registration confirmation number.
3. Last, due to limited seats in most of our clubs, all "completed" applications will be handled in the order they are received (first come, first served basis). Once you have been accepted into the club, you will receive information with instructions on how to pay for the club—Please be

patient! You will have 3 days to pay for the club once you receive the confirmation letter from Mrs. Duran. If the payment is not completed on time, a student on the waiting list will be given the opportunity to pay and granted the seat. Seats will not be held, NO exceptions! 😊

**\*\*Completing an online registration, does not secure your spot. Please make sure all forms are completed and returned (both online and paper) to obtain a seat in the club. Completed applications will be processed first, incomplete applications will be returned.**

**All payments will be made online. The payment portal will be available once all applications are processed (within 3-7 days). Please do not make any payments on the portal until instructed. We will not be able to reimburse if you change your mind or club is not running due to low enrollment.**

### **Arrival & Dismissal**

Students will be dismissed to ELOP Panther Clubs at 2:15pm on their club meeting days. At 2:15, students will report to the cafeteria. Students will be supervised in the cafeteria until the club sponsors arrive at 2:45pm.

**Student pickup will be at 3:45 (back bus loop).** Students who are in the ASP program will be dismissed back to the aftercare program once the club is over.

Each club will have a check-in and a check out system. Upon the students' arrival, the paraprofessional will take attendance. Students will be released only to the adults listed on the student's Panther Club registration form. Students who are not picked up at the end of the club sessions-3:45pm, must be picked up from the office and will be charged a late fee. **Parents will incur a \$15 late fee the first time and will be terminated from future sessions if tardy again. Please be on time!**

### **Afterschool Programs (ASP)**

Please note that ELOP- Panther Clubs are separate from ASP. Both programs have separate fees. Parents who are not able to pick up their children from clubs by 3:45 may pay for their child to be placed in ASP, if seats are available. ASP is available until 6:00pm daily. If your child is currently enrolled in ASP, they will be given a 10% discount for each club. Once the club is over, your child will join their ASP groups.

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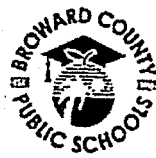
