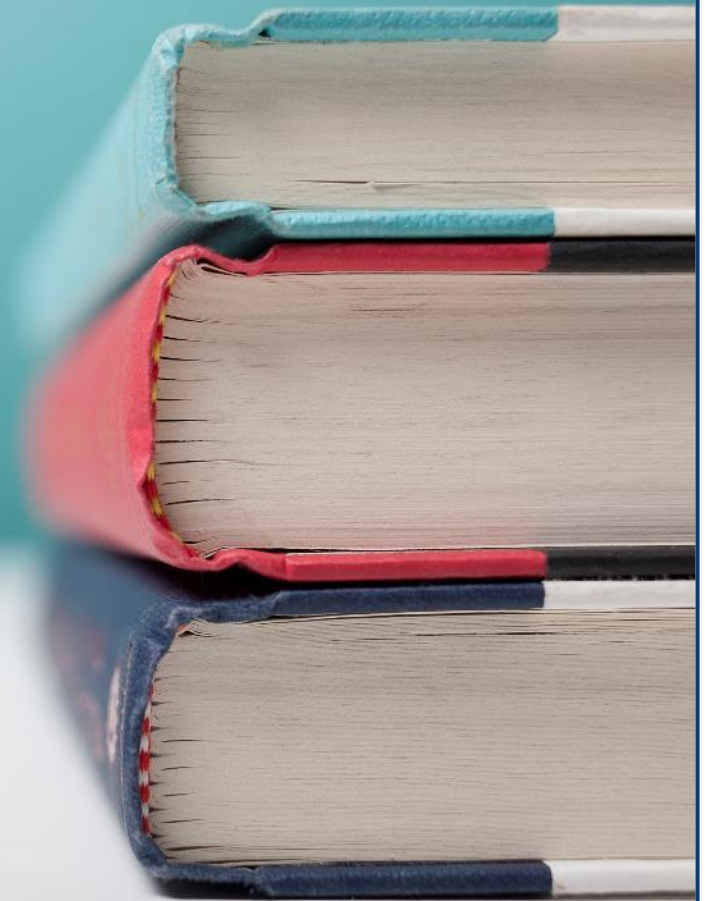

Mr. Castillo, *Intern Principal*

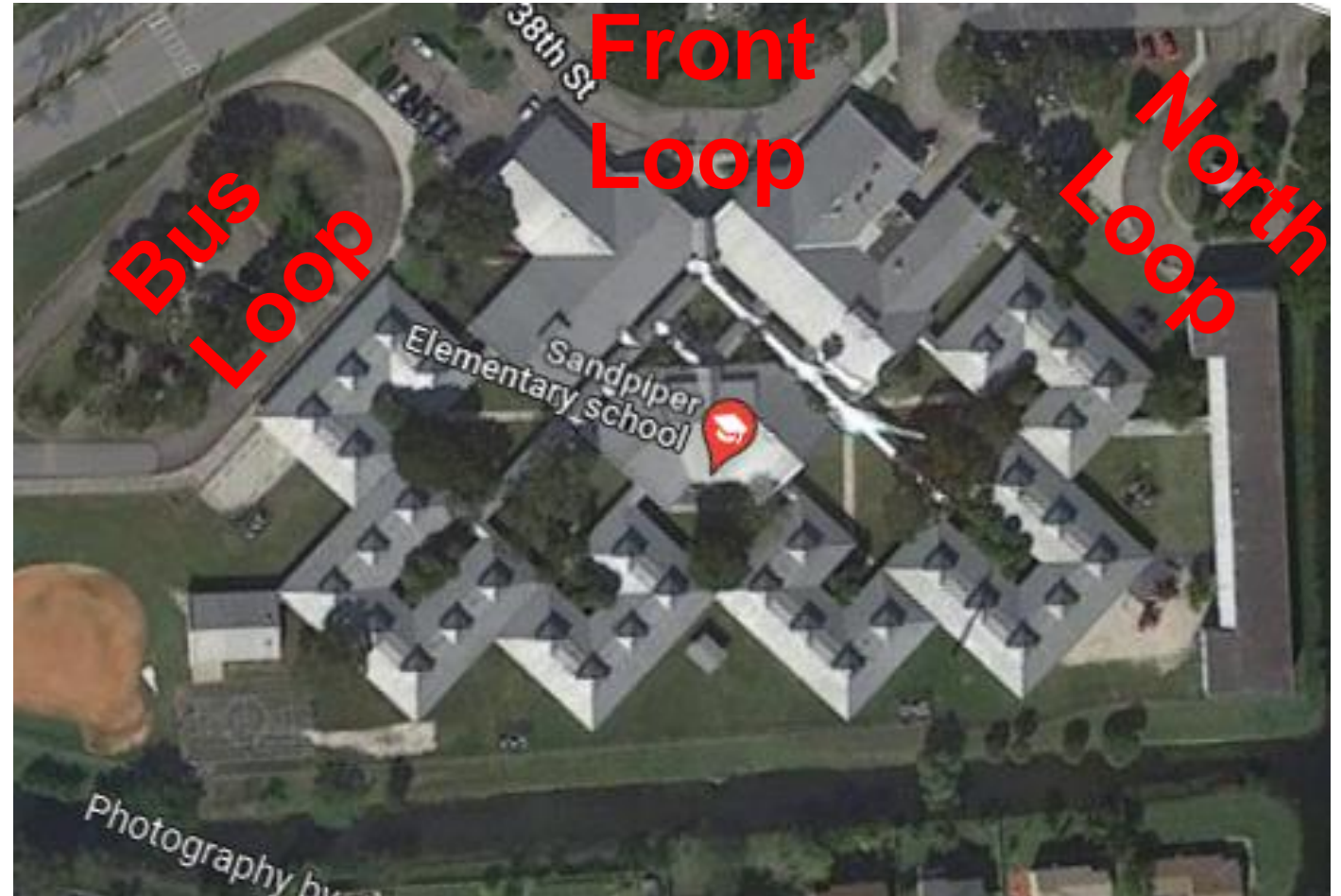
- **Student hours**
  - Student hours: 8:30am-12:30pm

- **Attendance**

  - Critical for 3<sup>rd</sup> Grade promotion

# 3<sup>rd</sup> Grade Reading Academy

- Eligibility
- The SAT-10 will be used for promotion for 3<sup>rd</sup> Grade Summer Reading Academy
- The assessment will be administered on:
  - Tuesday, July 26, 2022
  - Make-up day: Wednesday, July 27, 2022
  - Students must score in the 45<sup>th</sup> percentile or higher on the SAT-10 to be promoted to fourth grade
- Results on whether students will be promoted or not will be available in Virtual Counselor to the parent(s)/guardian(s) of tested students
